Scope of the Event

The Community Building Workshops provide a tool for segregated schools to network with the local community, in order to make the schools more successful and diverse. The first Community Building Workshop of the Inclusion4Schools project took place in Budapest, Hungary, on March 25, 2022. The MÁV-Telepi Wesley Primary School was the first pilot school to join the Community Building Workshop. Wesley College planned to invite parents, educators, representatives of the living environment and civic associations, as well as helpers and experts, to bring to a table and discuss the strengths and weaknesses of the school.

Participants

Due to several difficulties, there were only 15 participants, but they were widely represented: school teachers, school management, maintainer, municipal delegates, local residents (one of them a former student), and Roma activists participated as well. The absence of parents and local NGOs can be traced back to systematic problems.

Summary of topics and outcomes

The goal of the program was to strengthen the partnership between the school and the community. The first event was about getting to know each other better and building trust. After the ice-breaking game the participants introduced themselves in pairs. In small groups, a SWOT analysis was performed, then the results were presented and reflected on. At the end of the event, participants gave positive feedback.

Conclusions

The SWOT analysis will be supplemented with the parental responses. On 21, April, 2022, we will continue the community building with the involvement of the parents and two NGOs.
