We invite you to submit your papers and participate in the Inclusion4Schools International Conference 2023. This conference is organized by the <u>Inclusion4Schools European Horizon 2020 project</u>, aimed at promoting inclusive education for all learners to enhance and uptake education to reverse inequalities.

The conference will provide a forum for researchers, practitioners, teachers, civil society organizations, activists, journalists, and policy-makers to present and discuss their latest research, practices, and policy initiatives related to educational inequalities in Europe. The language of the conference is English.

The aim of the conference is:

- to enhance the cooperation of researchers, developers, educators and other actors like
 policy makers, practitioners and civil society representatives, but also between students,
 parents & teachers;
- to coordinate the pioneering activities of disadvantaged schools and their communities;
- to interact with other projects & initiatives to enhance synergies and cooperation between them and amongst the relevant stakeholders;
- to generate networks for research and policy development;
- to address practitioners to strengthen social integrity and solidarity;
- to break down the walls of exclusion;
- to incorporate the knowledge accumulated at the conference into Inclusion4Schools' policy recommendations;
- to build community to overcome the challenges of inequalities.

Submissions of contribution:

We welcome submissions of empirical, theoretical, but also practical and policy-oriented papers. Submissions should be written in English and should follow the formatting guidelines provided on the submission form.

The conference will be organized around **short presentations** (20 min) with space for open discussion. All presentations at the conference will be included in the **abstract book**.

Possible themes for papers include, but are not limited to:

- Science for Society to Reverse Inequalities and the Practitioners of Inclusion
- Pioneering Policies & Practices Tackling Educational Inequalities in Europe
- School-community Partnership for Reversing Inequality and Exclusion
 - Role of communities in addressing inequalities
 - Education rights of segregated communities and the right of preschool education
 - Transformative Practices of Segregated Schools
- Educational Common Spaces; Passing through enclosures and reversing inequalities
